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


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Work-Based Learning in Action: The Waukee Model

May 2024 - Senate File 2411 passed:

- clarified a consistent definition of work-based learning as, "sustained project-based learning in partnership with an employer, simulated work experiences aligned with industry-recognized credentials, high-quality pre-apprenticeships aligned to an apprenticeship, student learner programs, internships, and apprenticeships.
- Over 65% of 2028 class must have WBL experience
